What is the 2010 Senior Class Gift Campaign?

Is there a deadline to give my Senior Class Gift?

We strongly urge seniors to give their gift by April 1, 2010 so their name will appear on the Honor Roll of Donors at www.mycnr.com , in the graduation program, and in the summer 2010 issue of CNR’s Quarterly magazine. However, you can give your gift at any time thereafter.

What if I want to give my \$20.10 gift but don’t have it at this moment?
